Changes In Judicial Assignments In The Criminal Trial Division Effective Monday, January 5, 2004

The Honorable Doris Pechkurow is assigned to the List Program and will preside in Courtroom 505. Judge Pechkerow will assume the felony waiver inventory previously assigned to the Honorable Bradley K. Moss.

The Honorable Peter F. Rogers' inventory will be designated homicide only. Judge Rogers will continue to preside in Courtroom 1101 and remain in Section B. Judge Rogers' inventory will consist of homicide trial matters previously assigned to the Honorable Pamela Pryor Dembe and new cases randomly assigned from the homicide calendar room. Major felony cases previously assigned in Judge Rogers' inventory, which are not disposed, will be reassigned as trial listings to the Honorable George W. Overton commencing, January 19, 2004 and beyond.

The Honorable Kathryn Streeter-Lewis' inventory will be designated as homicide only. Judge Lewis will continue to preside in Courtroom 1008 and remain as Section C Leader. In addition to her present homicide inventory Judge Lewis will assume homicide cases presently listed as scheduling conferences in the inventory of the Honorable Pamela Pryor Dembe. Major Felony cases presently listed in Judge Lewis' inventory, which are not disposed, will be reassigned as trial listings to the inventory of the Honorable George W. Overton in Courtroom 1004 commencing January 19, 2004 and beyond.

Effective January 19, 2004, the Honorable George W. Overton is reassigned from the List Program to Section A in the Section Calendar Program and will continue to preside in Courtroom 1004. Judge Overton's inventory will consist of major felony cases reassigned from the inventories of the Honorable Peter F. Rogers and the Honorable Kathryn Streeter-Lewis.

The Honorable Pamela Pryor Dembe's inventory is designated as major felony only. Judge Dembe's homicide trial matters listed in calendar year 2004 will be reassigned to the Honorable Peter F. Rogers and will retain their present trial listings. Homicide cases presently listed in Judge Dembe's inventory, as scheduling conferences, will be reassigned to the Honorable Kathryn Streeter-Lewis.
