Are you required to pay child support in Philadelphia? Is your child support account behind? If so, vigorous enforcement actions will be initiated against you such as, but not limited to: incarceration up to 6 months; seizure of assets, bank accounts, and personal injury settlements; professional or driver's license suspension; passport denied; state and federal tax refunds intercepted; past due support reported to credit bureaus, and, judgments.

The Philadelphia Family Court's Networking for Jobs and Ex-offender Reentry Program was created to help unemployed or underemployed obligors who are required to pay child support find and keep full time employment. The Networking for Jobs and Ex-offender Reentry Program improves work opportunities for unemployed obligors by connecting them with provider agencies. The provider agencies assistance includes career counseling, job readiness classes, peer support, weekly transpass, job placement, on-going contact with career counselors, and additional training.

Did you know that 75% of the obligors referred to the court's job program found employment and 69% of those jobs provided medical benefits. Many of the obligors had misdemeanor and or felony criminal backgrounds.

To be eligible for the court's jobs program you must:

- Have a Philadelphia child support case
- Be 18 years old or older
- Be a Philadelphia resident
- Be a United States citizen
- Be physically and mentally employable
- Be drug free
- Have no sexual abuse or arson criminal history
