- Q1. Is a Surety required with the submitted proposal? If so, what is the amount needed?***
At this time, a bond or deposit is not required.
- Q2. The RFP describes an increased volume from approximately 2,000 Writs issued for the 2015 Fiscal Year to 4,000 Writs estimated to be needed served for the 2016 Fiscal Year. Is there a reason for this 100% increase or is this just an estimate?***
Based on Family Court's projections, research indicates that the number of writs served annually has increased but will not exceed 4,000.
